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Note 1:

The allocation of \$8,000 to bring a senior instructor equivalent from Europe to teach the first batch of speedflying instructors will be carefully planned to ensure that the instructor's expenses are covered while also providing the necessary resources for an effective training program. A significant portion will likely be allocated to the instructor's expenses, such as airfare, accommodation, and daily rate. The airfare cost can vary depending on the instructor's location and the time of year. Accommodation expenses may include hotel rooms, meals, and transportation. The daily rate for the instructor will depend on their level of experience and expertise, as well as the duration of the training program. The daily rate typically covers the instructor's time and knowledge and is standard practice for instructors of this calibre.
